## ▲ POLISH CONCRETE MOVES INDOORS

The Pentagon table from Morgan & Möller is made from natural concrete in a raw, dynamic format. Its irregular and simple shape is an interesting single element that would be the centre of attention in a suitable interior. The tables can be joined together in a variety of structures, for example, for waiting areas in receptions, relaxation areas in offices or for the patio. The manufacturer, Polish company Vinderen, boasts that the structures are considerably lighter than they appear – each table weighs 40 kg. Thanks to the concrete spray method, the inside of the furniture is hollow. Pentagon is 40 cm high, 76 cm wide and 56 cm deep.

## ▼ EXTERNAL LIGHTING CONFIGURED ON-LINE

Trilux offers a new, intuitive configurator system for the parameters of ConStela LED lighting columns. The internet application makes it possible to simply adjust the product to the requirements of a building. The preview is generated in real time. Depending on the modules used, the system provides general lighting for urban space or lighting that accentuates the illumination of specific facilities. Its multi-lens technology has two variants: one with asymmetrical and the other with symmetrical light distribution. The configurator features the option of choosing from a number of modules that differ in diameter, design, light distribution characteristics and the warmth of the colour of the light emitted.



## ◀ STEEL BATH FOR LEED

As the fashion for all things environmental becomes the norm in hotels, potential guests are now paying attention to such matters. This is why Kaldewei has developed fittings with extended durability. Steel, enamel baths and shower bases can be used for longer and can later be fully recycled. The product itself is partly manufactured from recycled steel. In addition, the enamel covering the steel, which is 3.5 mm thick, has no pores – which means a reduction in the damage and scratches where small quantities of soap, fungi or bacteria could build up. The use of detergents is therefore reduced.



## ◀ 'NO' TO ROUND SHAPES – IN THE BATHROOM TOO

The Bellis shower set from Ferro is a proposal for modern bathrooms that do not always go together with traditional round shapes. The handles of the shower are flat in a rather oblong shape. The white shower heads combine perfectly with the chrome plating. The handles are equipped with a check valve and the 'easy to clean system', which can make a significant difference in hotel bathrooms, where the speed and precision of the cleaning work is crucial.



## ▲ XPLAN DESIGNS NAIL CLINIC SALON

Xplan has finished the construction and design work on a beautician's salon in the Eurocentrum Office Complex on Al. Jerozolimskie in Warsaw. Xplan was responsible for the preparation of the Nail Clinic premises and the installation of the electrical, ICT, water and sewage, ventilation and air-conditioning systems, as well as the fitting of the flooring, ceilings, wallpapers, furniture, wall painting, delivery, lighting and other interior design elements. The pastel interiors of the salon have been designed in the shabby chic style by Agata Biedermann and Małgorzata Szczepaniak of the BSD-Architekt studio. The 50 sqm salon was developed by Grupa Capital Park.
